The Euraba Paper Company is an Aboriginal community enterprise that produces handmade papers and is located in rural NSW in the North west.

The dream of establishing an Aboriginal community paper mill began in 1996 when nine senior Goomeroi women commenced art classes at the Boggabilla TAFE College with Paul West as their teacher.

Challenges - combining Aboriginal traditions with business policies and deadlines. Marketing and distributing product. Refining production facilities and the working environment. Increasing production within the mill.

Our Euraba papers are extremely strong and richly pigmented. They are made from 100% cotton rag off-cuts, supplied by local clothing manufacturers. Waste that would otherwise be contributing to a landfill. Our certificate papers are predominately natural with additive of natural grasses or local fibres. The flecks of grass represent our Aboriginal peoples strong attachment to the country in our region. ■
